## COACH RESNICK'S COMMANDMENTS OF HOCKEY

## **TEN COMMANDMENTS:**

- 1. I WILL skate my lane.
- 2. I WILL keep two hands on my stick and my stick on the ice.
- 3. I WILL NOT turn my back to the puck or to my opponent's goal.
- 4. I WILL NOT get a penalty when my team is behind.
- 5. I WILL NOT go backward in our zone except on a power play.
- 6. I WILL NOT go offside on a two-on-one, three-on-one, or three-on-two—straddle the blue line.
- 7. I WILL control my wing between the blue lines.
- 8. I WILL NOT hog the puck, except when I am left alone.
- 9. I WILL keep my body between the puck and the man.
- 10. IF I am in a shooting position, I WILL take the shot.

## **RULES OF PASSING:**

- 1. I WILL NEVER pass to the man standing still.
- 2. I WILL NEVER pass the puck foolishly.
- 3. I WILL ALWAYS pass the puck to improve our offensive position.
- 4. I WILL keep my head up and never pass to the covered man.
- 5. I WILL headman the puck.
- 6. AFTER passing the puck, I WILL skate to get into position for a return pass.
- 7. I WILL NEVER pass diagonally in my own zone unless 100 percent sure of the pass.
- 8. I WILL NOT pass or carry the puck in front of my own net or throw it out blindly from behind the net.
- 9. I WILL pass the puck into the offensive zone—only if I have no skating room and no one to pass to.

## **MAN-DATORIES:**

- 1. Skate to the puck.
- 2. I WILL take the man if I cannot get the puck.
- 3. I WILL backcheck and pick up the open man when the other team has the puck.
- 4. One on one, I WILL ALWAYS take the man.
- 5. I WILL check the man passing the puck.
- 6. First man in takes the puck carrier.
- 7. Second man in takes the puck.
- 8. Player in front of the net must face the puck and lean on his stick.
- 9. You must never allow the team to be outnumbered in its own zone.
- 10. Puck carrier is never the last man to leave the zone.
